- Maximum skaters 18, Goalies 3, 21 TOTAL. All 3 goalies can dress. **Deadline for changes is 5:00pm on May 17, 2018**
- Maximum staff on roster-6. Only five can be on the bench for a game. No rotation during game.
- When completing your player roster your coaches and managers can be added in the non-player personnel.

Game Format

- Every game starts with a fresh sheet of ice
- 5 Minute Warm-up
 - Warm up pucks are available on request
- First 20 minutes running time, 2 minute penalty becomes 3 minutes. 5 minutes becomes 7.5 minutes.
- 2nd Period is 20 minutes stop time.
- Ice Clean
- 3rd Period is 20 minutes stop time. Ice clean.

FIVE PUCK GAME



- Played only after ALL Round Robin Games only if games completed in regulation.
- 5 mins on clock
- Each team uses all players in succession until all 5 pucks are gone or time runs out – All players go once, then start over if necessary
- Score kept for time and number of goals
- The Five Puck Game will not be played if the game goes into overtime. In this situation, the winner of OT will be recorded as the winner with time recorded as it stands in OT.

RULES & REGULATIONS

- Rules & Regulations are online at www.challengecup.com
- Points System for Games:
 - 3 points for a regulation win
 - 2 points for an overtime win
 - 1 point for an overtime loss
- ALL GAMES MUST RESULT IN A WINNER
 - **Round-Robin Overtime Format**
 - 3 vs 3 for five minutes and then shoot-out
 - **Elimination Overtime Format**
 - 4 vs 4 for 5 minutes then 3 vs 3 for 5 minutes, shoot out.



RULES & REGULATIONS

- BODY CHECKING is permitted at the PEEWEE MAJOR 2005 and older.
- NO BODY CHECKING in any of the Girl's Divisions.
- MERCY RULE: Running time starts only in 3rd period, if 5 goal lead.
- NO GOAL DIFFERENTIAL MAXIMUM

ROSTER ITEMS

- Maximum 18 Skaters & Goalies 3 for total of 21 players.
- All 3 goalies can dress.
- Maximum staff on roster-6. Only five can be on the bench for a game. No rotation during game.
- Skills testing question: When is the deadline for your roster submission?



STANDING TIEBREAKERS

The following is the format to determine the final standings in the event of a tie:

- 1) Most points
 - 2) Team with the greatest number of wins
 - 3) Games against team with equal record (this will not be utilized if the tie involves 3 or more teams)
 - 4) Basic goal differential GF-GA
 - 5) Total goal differential GF-GA/GF
 - 6) Team with fewest penalty minutes
 - 7) Goals for
 - 8) Goals against
 - 9) Most periods won
 - 10) Earliest goal scored
- Please note that misconducts and game misconducts will count as 10 penalty minutes.
